



Multi-Domain Battle Overview

Multi-Domain Battle enables Joint Maneuver and presents *multiple options* to national leadership and *multiple dilemmas* to potential adversaries. MDB:

- Provides periods of *relative advantage* in support of Joint operations
- *Integrates* existing and future Joint capabilities to defeat any near-peer potential adversary or rogue state
- *Employs Mission Command principles* and technologies to empower leaders to operate semi-independently
- *Strengthens deterrence* and *increases the lethality and resiliency* of the Joint Force
- *Is evolutionary change* that will have *revolutionary impact* in every theater around the globe

Multi-Domain Battle is being developed by the U.S. Army and Marine Corps in collaboration with the U.S. Pacific Command service components and the Department of Defense Strategic Capability Office
